Dear Parent and Carers,

The government's latest announcement explained that schools will remain open from Monday for children who are within the category of 'key worker' or 'vulnerable'. If your child falls into any of these categories we will be here to welcome them on Monday morning from 8am.

Further details will follow later today including a request for confirmation of whether you plan to send your child to school – please action this request as soon as reasonably possible to support us in preparing for Monday.

Dress Code: Your child is not expected to wear school uniform and we ask them to wear trainers so they are able to engage in some physical activity during the day.

Activities/Lessons: We are working hard to develop a suitable programme of learning for the children who attend and this will develop over the days and weeks to come.

Catering: We will provide meals for our students as per our normal school system.

Timings: Timings may develop dependent of the needs of our local community. On Monday we will be following our Wednesday timings of no form time. We will be offering after school clubs – please inform us if you would like your child to attend these.

Where students should go on Monday when they arrive: Both upper and lower gate will be open with members of the leadership team around to welcome our students. All students are asked to go straight to the Art classrooms at upper site by 8:40am. I will personally be there to talk to the students and go through their day.

Further queries: I am sure you will have more questions regarding our In-School Offer and I ask that you contact us via email or phone. As you can imagine we have a larger number of emails and calls coming into the school than normal and I ask for your patience in the timeliness of our response. We will continue to work as quickly and thoroughly as possible.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support and to add that now we are working very differently and providing two offers, one remotely and one in school, that we will continue to try our very best to provide a suitable learning experience for our students.
