As you are aware, the school will now be shut until further notice and we understand you may have questions and concerns. Please be reassured that we will continue to support you with your learning whilst we are closed and here are a few ways this will happen.

Google classroom

You will need to log in to your school Google account to access your google Drive and classrooms. Your learning managers have asked who has not got access to ICT at home and for those of you, we will provide paper copies for as much work as we can. Work will be posted onto the Google classroom for each of your subjects, the work can range from completing online tasks, past papers or making notes from books or revision guides previously issued.

The google classrooms will be checked and updated daily. Work which is submitted will be marked as soon as possible. Please make sure you have accepted any requests to join the classes.

A whole year classroom has been created and named 'Intake2015'. Please join it using the code: **g4yrakj** so I can post daily updates to you all and you can keep in touch with me directly. Miss Croft, Miss Sipson and all the learning managers will also have access to this classroom.
